Dear Parents/Carers

In recent weeks, we have had repeated incidences in school related to children bringing in toys from home. This has led to disputes, damage to home toys and things going missing. We respectfully request that children do not bring any toys into school, unless this is for a particular reason that has been pre-arranged with a member of staff. This would help to prevent issues and conflict arising in school, which teaching staff are having to spend time sorting out and ultimately this has an impact upon learning time.

We are aware that children who stay for our wraparound provision on particular days have been bringing in 'Yu-Gi-Oh!' cards to play with other children and staff members as part of an organised activity. If children still wish to bring in their cards, they must be in a named envelope that can be left in the school office for safekeeping during the school day.

Any toys brought into school will be kept by the child's class teacher in a safe place and returned to them or their parents at the end of the school day.
