Thrive

Mrs Davies will be continuing in her role as Thrive practitioner next year, working with children across school to support their social and emotional wellbeing. We believe that children flourish when they are confident, self-assured and resilient.

What is Thrive?

Thrive is a licenced whole school and individual approach to support. Mrs Davies has undergone extensive training to become a Thrive practitioner and her training is updated regularly. Thrive was created by a multi – agency team consisting of former teachers, advisers, OFSTED inspectors, social workers, family therapists and foster and adoption specialists. It is based on established neuroscience, attachment theory and child development. It is based on growing evidence that the Brain develops through consistent, positive, personal interaction.

Children thrive in enabling environments where their learning needs and early experiences are understood and responded to by caring adults. Our aim, through Thrive, is to build strong partnerships with our children and their families to enable our children to flourish and become life – long learners.

Next year, Mrs Davies will be running some Thrive coffee mornings to support parents to understand more about the approach. Look out for these dates in future bulletins!
