Message from PCSO Matthew Johnson

The parking situation outside of the school has been brought to the attention of Solihull Police over the past few weeks. I have spoken to parents who have stressed that some of the parking poses a danger to pupils crossing the road, to enter the school gates.

The first concern is at both bottom corners of Danbury Road, which takes you on to Halifax Road. Vehicles have been seen to be parking on these corners, which obstructs the view for parents and pupils crossing the road. In addition, these corners are marked with double yellow lines, meaning that any vehicles parked here can be penalised.

Secondly, there have been reports of parking within the keep clear markings directly outside the school gates. Again, this is highly dangerous and I must stress that all parents abide by the Highway Code. People parking here will be penalised.

Solihull Police will continue to monitor the parking situation, and will conduct school patrols in marked and unmarked vehicles where possible. If you would like to report dangerous parking, please email myself: <u>Matthew.Johnson1@westmidlands.police.uk</u>.

Pupil Eco – Council Message

We are working hard to try and achieve the Green Flag award for our school this year and need your assistance to help make our school more eco-friendly.

We have noticed there is a lot of waste in our lunch bin, and we want to try and reduce this as much as we can. We have decided to ask all children who bring packed lunches to school to take all their packaging and left over food home with them. We hope that this will make it easier for families to use re-usable packaging wherever possible, and to recycle other packaging in your home recycling (we would also encourage you to compost any leftover fruit and vegetables if you are able to).

We really hope that by doing this we can reduce the amount of waste going into landfill.

Many of you will know that our menu at St James is meat free on Mondays. We would also like children who have packed lunches to try and join in with this by avoiding meat products on Mondays. We have found that eating more plant-based foods is not only healthy but helps to reduce our carbon footprint too. Thank you for your help and support and we look forward to sharing more of our ideas with you soon.
